


NEW KABAALÉ BUSEGA PRIMARY SCHOOL NON-FINANCIAL ANNUAL REPORT – 2025

PEARL OF AFRICA CHILDREN'S CHOIR



CHALLENGES OF THE TERM

HYGIENE

The girls' bathroom structure is very old. It has an old cracked floor and walls. It's not conducive towards their hygiene. With lack of enough resources in the school we are forced to spend more in repairs which is still a challenge due to the high costs involved.

SCHOOL COMPOUND

The school is facing a challenge of the school compound due to soil. Tarmacking the compound could help us get more children. We also need a drainage system to drain water from school towards the school gate to avoid the soil being carried away by running water.

ICT LESSONS

The pupils have been introduced to Computer lessons from Primary one to Primary Six. The laptops in use now are seven for the whole school including teachers. The school is lacking enough laptops to help in teaching the learners well.



P3 BLOCK/GIRLS' DORMITORY

This is the old structure block which holds P.1, P.2, P3 and Girls' dormitory has served for several years hence making its walls and roofing weak. Its roof is low making it hot during sunny days and being old makes it leak during rainy days. It's not a favorable environment for our learning pupils. For the boarders, if their section could be self-contained to avoid moving out at night for security purposes it would promote our school more. This block has so far received a donation of 100 sheets from Leonie Bell one of the Trustees of Pearl of Africa Child Care Ltd. We say "Webale Nyo"!!



LACK OF A PERIMETER FENCE

The school site is not fully fenced and gated, this causes security problems and supervision of children during breaks and after classes.
